

Brief Description of the Youth Exchange

"Culture takes diverse forms across time and space. This diversity is embodied in the uniqueness and plurality of the identities of the groups and societies making up humankind. As a source of exchange, innovation and creativity, cultural diversity is as necessary for humankind as biodiversity is for nature. For a society to become really intercultural, every social group must be able to live in the conditions of equality regardless of their culture, lifestyle or origin. This means reconsidering not only how we interact with cultures which seem strange to our own, but also how we interact with minorities who face many forms of intolerance and discrimination. Intercultural education is one of the main tools we have nowadays to help us take advantage of the opportunities offered by multicultural societies.

Lack of intercultural understanding often leads to racial discrimination, intolerance, denigration and violence locally and globally. The nowadays conflicts in the world are sad illustrations of the problems that can arise from an inability to respect and live with other cultures. Intercultural education is also an effective way of addressing the modern phenomena of racism and racial discrimination and intolerance.

Goals and Methods

With the youth exchange "Beyond Borders' Youth Camp" we aim to gather together youngsters from different cultures, backgrounds as we believe that young people are the ground of the community we live in. We believe that this project will help to change attitudes and behaviours of young people towards diversity and discrimination and encourage adults to recognize the value that young people's contributions bring to society at local, national and international levels. Through the exchange, the participants will understand that their differences are enrichment for all of them, and that all of them are part of the common idea of European Identity.


The objectives of the youth exchange are:


- To enable young people to learn more about their own culture, to deepen their cultural roots and to reaffirm their identity

- To inspire local youth to be engaged in similar youth activities and to learn about Erasmus+ programme.
- To develop creative thinking, soft skills, of youngsters and youth leaders.

How to get to the venue

If you are traveling with your team, the most convenient way to get from Riga Airport to Riga Central Station is the **BOLT** app - this taxi app provides cheap services. Even if you split the cost for two (to the center of Riga it will be about € 7-10). Here's what the app looks like:

How to get to the venue with public transport


From <u>Riga Airport</u> to the <u>Riga City Center</u> you have to take a bus or minibus 22 and get out at the stop "Autoosta". Ticket price: 2 EUR

From the stop "Autoosta" you have to walk about 2 minutes (160 m.) to the <u>Riga Bus Station</u>.

At the Bus Station you buy a ticket to **OLTUŽI**. Buses go every one and half hour. On road time will be about 1 hour 30 minutes. <u>Be aware</u> that the last bus is at 21:55. If you won't catch it the only option is taxi. Ticket price: *4 EUR

Attention: You will <u>have to ask bus driver</u> to let you get out from bus at station **VECMUIŽAS SKOLA**.


Bus stop: Vecmuižas Skola

As our venue is located in pure nature of Latvian forests, fresh air and eco lifestyle, it is not usual stop for public busses.


Before your bus will arrive to <u>OLTUŽI</u>, you will have to get out at bus stop **VECMUIŽAS SKOLA**. Not every driver in Latvia knows English, so <u>we highly</u> recommend to <u>print</u> the following text and present it to driver as soon as you get in the bus in Riga (bus will stop <u>only by request</u>):

Labdien. Es esmu ārzemnieks. Lūdzu apstādiniet autobusu Vecmuižas skolā (līdz OLTUŽIEM). ES DZĪVOJU VIESU NAMĀ VECMUIŽA. Liels Paldies par sapratni!

And, as the end of the journey, 5 minutes walk will bring you to **VIESU NAMS VECMUIŽA**!




COVID-19 RULES

Travel Reimbursement

International travel expenses can be reimbursed **ONLY** upon presentation of **ALL ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS** stating your travel information and costs, namely:

- 1. Boarding passes (For round trip),
- 2. Tickets (Also e-tickets),
- 3. Receipts (In case the tickets are bought by cash),
- 4. Invoices and card payment history (In case the tickets are bought by bank card),
- 5. Payment checks / Bank statements.

Participants are requested to bring with them all mentioned documents, likewise, any other payment bills, checks, tickets and payment prove that they will get during the travel. Regarding way-back tickets and boarding passes, they should be sent by <u>international post service</u> to "YSTREET" in Latvia (example: check-in at airport) or by e-mail (if they were issued through online check-in). **SCANS / PHOTOS / SCREENSHOTS ARE NOT ALLOWED!!!**

Because of Erasmus+ rules, unfortunately we cannot reimburse Taxi costs.

Reimbursement for ALL COUNTRIES will be done by BANK TRANSFER after we have all original tickets and relevant documents.
