DATE AND LOCATION

The project will take place in Ceuta, Spain from from **08**th to **15**th of **March 2024**.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

This project seeks to become an educational platform for youth workers, a collaborative space for representatives of NGOs, a booster to activate the local community and a unique opportunity to experience and reflect on the realities at the gateway of European migration. The training is designed to address the key challenges of Youth Work on topics of migration, multiculturalism and diversity, such as - Anti-Immigrant Attitudes and a Rise in Nationalism and Xenophobia. Creation of a safe space for youngsters, fostering intercultural dialogue and overcoming language barriers. Chosen Methodologies to address the needs - Non-formal, Participatory storytelling, Verbal and Non-verbal

OBJECTIVES

We have set the following objectives for the projects:

- To introduce Participatory Art methodologies, including verbal and nonverbal approaches to youth workers and participating organisations
- To educate youth workers with the theory and practice of non-formal methodology in a holistic and systematic manner.
- To provide time and space for the development of collaborations and initiatives to the participating organisations and interchange of experience
- To see the situation in depth at the gateway of migration to Europe and reflect on the experience (video format)
- To have a close look at interracial, interreligious and intercultural aspects of migration

The mobility will take place in the Spanish autonomous city in the north coast of Africa, **CEUTA.**



Situated beside a bay, the fortified city of Ceuta has watched over the strait of Gibraltar since long ago. The walled area presides over the old quarter of this Cosmopolitan Mediterranean city. Since ancient times, Ceuta's strategic location has encouraged the settlement of different civilizations.

Ceuta has a population of 82,376 habitants. Its population consists of Christians, Muslims and small minorities of Sephardic Jews and ethnic Sindhi Hindus.

Spanish is the official language, while Darija Arabic is also spoken by 40-50% of the population, which is of Moroccan origin.



TRAVELLING TO THE VENUE

The best way to reach Ceuta is going to Algeciras and then taking a ferry from there. There are several ways to get into Algeciras as stated below:

- You can also fly to Madrid or Barcelona and then to connect with one of the Andalusian cities



A) From Malaga:

If your intention is to travel from Malaga to Algeciras by bus, you could take one of the many buses of the company PORTILLO, which makes this distance every day. The price for this trip vary between 15 and 18 Euros, being the time of the

trip 1 hour and 45 minutes (direct service), and 3 hours and 15 minutes (regular service).

B) From Seville:

In case to travel from Seville to Algeciras by bus you have to pick up one of the buses of the company COMES. The bus station in Seville from where you need to take the bus is called 'El Prado de San Sebastian" bus station. Approximate duration of the trip is 3 hours and 30 minutes. You can consult the schedules here. Approximate price of the trip Seville – Algeciras is 21 Euros.

C) From Cádiz

If you prefer to travel from Cadiz, you have to take one of the COMES company buses that circulate among these two cities every day. The duration of the trip ranges between 1 hour and 45 minutes and 2 hours and 15 minutes (depending on the selected schedule). You can check the schedules clicking here.

Price of this trip is around 16 Euros.

TRAVEL & HEALTH INSURANCE
